Chapter Awards

Based on the addition of a CTSO for an approved CTE Program, each DECA Chapter is required to reach the Bronze Chapter Award. This program is designed to provide recognition for our Chapters while ensuring that our membership is strong and active. All documentation for awards will be due on **February 3rd**. Go to azdeca.org website, under **Advisor Tab** and Click on the **Resources/Links**.

Bronze Chapter (Required for all Chapters)

1. Must fill out the JOT Form for the ADE (7a items)

- a. <https://azed.jotform.com/240525994078870>
- b. Local Chapter Constitution/Bylaws submitted each year to State Office
- c. Minimum membership requirements by DECA (10 members and 1 advisor)
- d. Submit Program of Leadership (POL) to State Office.
 - i. Must be in the DECA Inc. [Format](#)

Bronze Level Chapters will receive an official certificate and their chapter name will be listed on the Arizona DECA Website.

Silver Chapter (Bronze Level plus the activities below)

1. Minimum of 20 members—*Required for DECA+ Subscription from Arizona DECA*
2. Attend at least two Arizona DECA Events
3. Hold at least four meetings per school year (Submit Minutes)
4. Plan and Host a Chapter Community Service Event
5. Invites an industry person to be a guest speaker in your class/chapter.

Silver Level Chapters will receive an official certificate, their chapter name on our website and Silver Chapter Ribbons at SCDC.

Gold Chapter (Silver Level plus the activities below)

1. Recruit a School Administrator to attend a local or state DECA Event.
2. Conduct at least one DECA PR Presentation (School Board, Civic Group, etc.)
3. Create a chapter budget for the current school year.
4. Complete two of the Chapter Campaigns: Membership, Promotional, Community Service, Ethical Leadership

Gold Level Chapters will receive a plaque at the State Career Development Conference, Gold Chapter Ribbons, Reserved Seating at SCDC Closing Session

Arizona Diamond Chapter (Gold level plus the activities below)

1. Recruit five (5) judges to judge at regional or state competition OR 1 workshop presenter for either the Fall or State Conference.
2. Have a Student Based Enterprise (SBE) that Certifies or Recertifies Gold for ICDC. (Verified with DECA Inc. After submission)
3. Do **one** of the following activities:
 - a. Have at least one student apply for an Arizona DECA state council.
 - b. Recruit at least 3 members for our DECA Alumni database system
 - c. Have at least one senior apply for an Arizona DECA Scholarship or a DECA Inc. scholarship.

Diamond level chapters will receive an official certificate, Diamond chapter ribbons at SCDC, chapter listed on the Arizona DECA website and app, a stage Diamond level banner presentation on stage at SCDC level, and upfront seating at the opening and closing session for SCDC.
